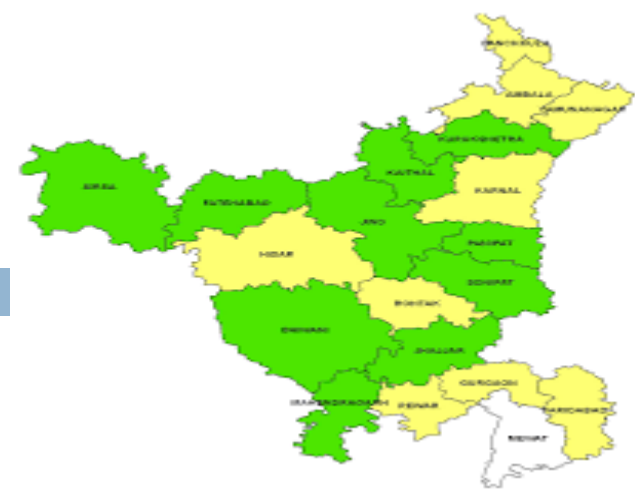

Sustainable and Low Cost Methods

-  **Cultural Practices:** Deep ploughing during dry summer season • Use of Pest Resistant varieties
• Inter Cropping, Crop Rotation and planting of Trap Crops • Weeding & harrowing
-  **Mechanical Methods:** Destruction of insects by hand picking and using hand nets • Use of Light Traps and Sticky Traps
-  **Biological Methods:** Use of Pheromone Traps, Predators, Parasites & Bio-pesticides
-  **Bio Pesticides:** Microbial pesticides: Trichoderma, NPV, Pseudomonas etc. • Botanical pesticides: Based on Neem, Garlic etc.

Precautions for Using Chemical Pesticides

-  Pesticides carrying red triangle are most toxic (followed by yellow, blue and green triangles).
-  Use doses as per Package of Practices otherwise as per indication on the label.
-  While spraying pesticides, wear full protective clothing such as mask, gloves etc.
-  Spray pesticides early morning or late evening and take bath after spray.
-  Spray in direction of wind and keep away from spray particles.
-  Keep pesticides, sprayers and mixing utensils locked away from children and pets.
-  Go for generic name of pesticide and always check expiry date on label.
-  In case of pesticide poisoning, take along pesticide container/leaflet to a doctor.

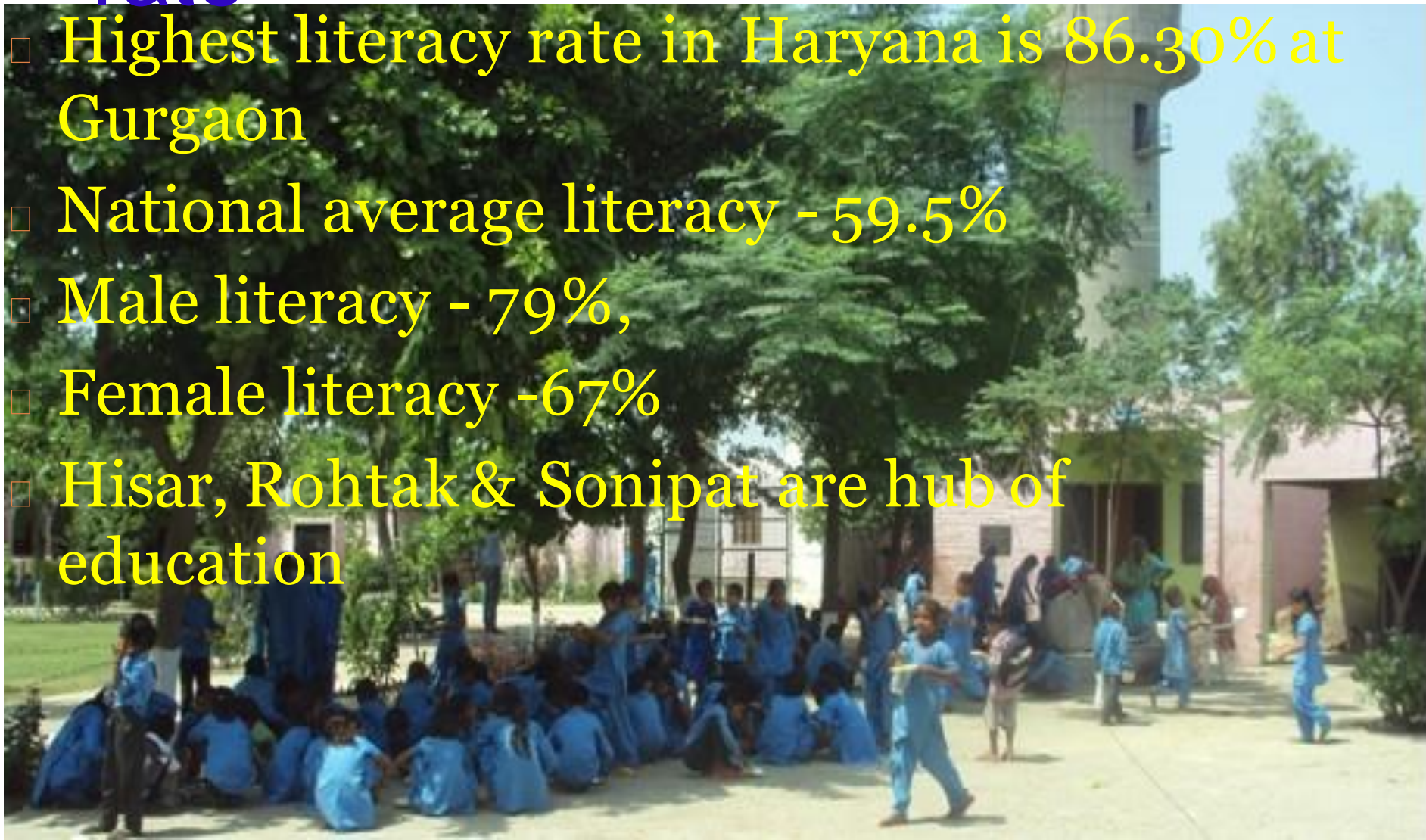

rate

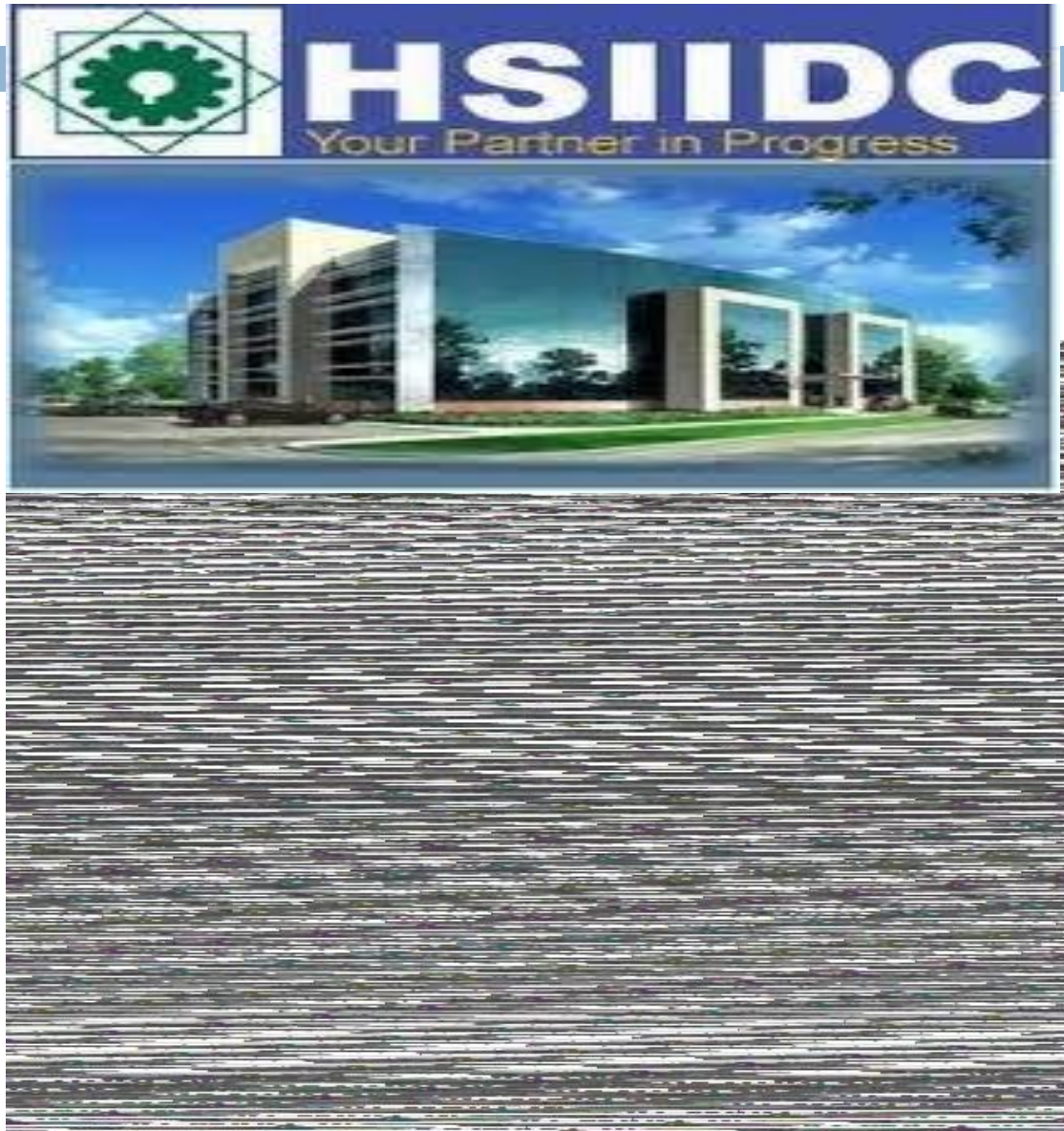
- Highest literacy rate in Haryana is 86.30% at Gurgaon

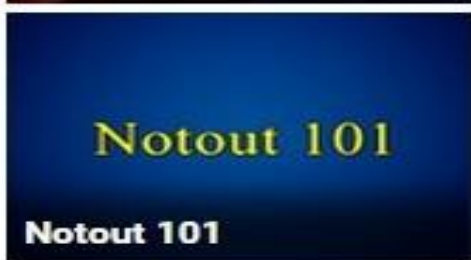
Haryanvi i Film

- Pagdi the Honour, released in 2014, national award



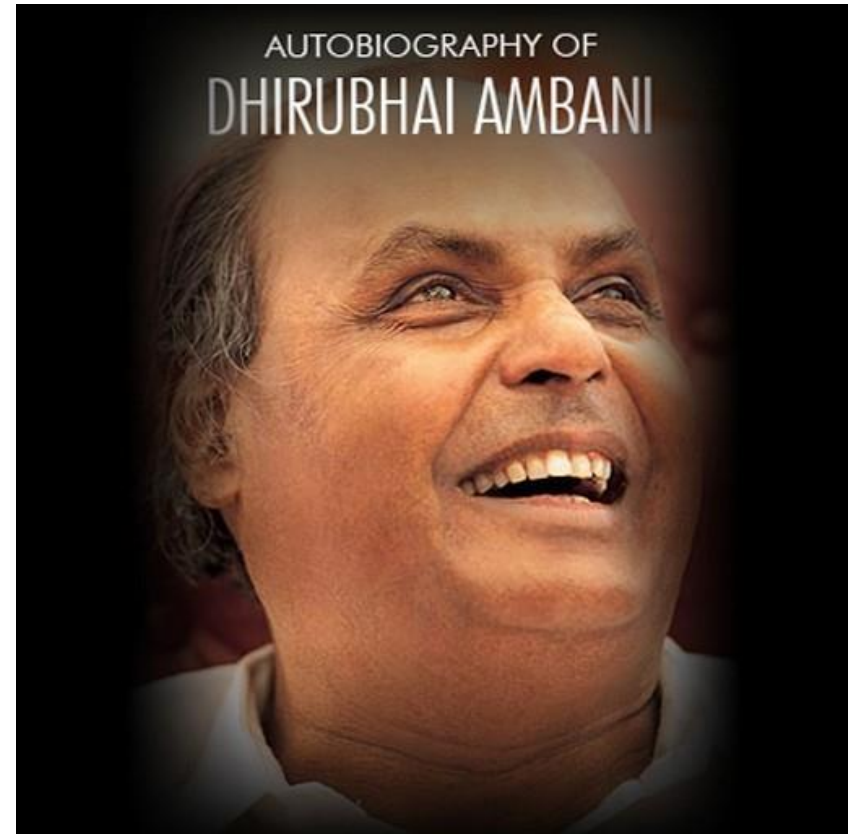
